**SAREY BY LANTERN LIGHT**, paperback, \$6.00

Sarey has a different way of seeing, but her teacher at the crowded city school doesn't recognize this. She blames her refusal to read on laziness. In fact, Sarey is dyslexic—a condition that in the 1970s was not so well recognized and understood as it is today. When Sarey's parents decide to move to far northern Maine—potato country—their dream to establish their own little house in the woods almost ends in disaster. For a crucial few hours in the falling dark of a snowy winter day, the success of her family's new life all depends on Sarey.
